

**DISTRICT OF HUDSON'S HOPE
POLICY**

SUBJECT: COMPOSTERS – Purchase Assistance for Residents
ADOPTED BY COUNCIL: May 29, 2006
AMENDED BY COUNCIL: July 6, 2009

In addition to being environmentally friendly, composting reduces costs for the municipality because it lessens the amount of garbage going into the waste stream.

2. Composters are available for purchase at a wide number of recycling and home and garden stores, including purchasing from the Northern Environmental Action Team (NEAT) or through Chetwynd Recycling.
3. To encourage composting in the District of Hudson's Hope, the District will provide a subsidy of \$20.00, but cannot be more than 50% of the value of the composter, to each household.
4. Residents must purchase the composter and present the receipt to the District of Hudson's Hope to receive the subsidy. The subsidy will be issued in the form of a cheque payable to the purchaser.
5. The municipality limits its subsidy to a maximum of one per household.
