

- although there are no identification numbers on the pick ups, they will have a company name and the licence plates are to be visible;
- contractors working for Talisman are the responsibility of Talisman when they are conducting work on their behalf;
- Talisman is committed to not moving rigs or large vehicles during school bus times, not using jake breaks in residential areas and they are aware of the noise issues, especially on frozen ground that makes sounds louder;
- dust control is part of their mandate and they will be looking at this issue in the spring;
- they are not aware of federal restrictions on dust control but they will do some research to find the specifics;
- they do not believe that the new road will change vendor location, as long as the services needed are provided locally and competitively priced, they are willing to use local businesses as much as possible;
- with the road not being built for two years the local businesses will have a head start to get their businesses recognized and build relationships with the company;
- a list of local contractors has been given to Talisman for future reference;
- they have currently spent 1.1 million dollars on local businesses;
- they are willing to support the initiative of trying to get runaway lanes built for both the Farrell Creek and Canyon Drive hills;
- representatives are willing to come and present updates to Council on a regular basis and are considering having an open house in the spring; and
- will look at putting up signage to advise of rig moves and have phone numbers for the public to report speeding.
