CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 pm with Mayor Harwood presiding.

ICBC Road Safety

The ICBC Road Safety team came to discuss highway traffic concerns with Council and to go look at each case with the Director of Works and Protective Services. The following concerns were brought up at the meeting:

- runaway lane on Canyon Drive hill;
- runaway lane on Farrell Creek hill;
- improvements on cache creek bridge and/or improved signage for yielding to oncoming traffic;
- sloughing of the road on Highway 29 (Watson hill);
- cleaning of highway signage;
- speed near the King Gething campground;
- mowing of the ditches and more signage to reduce crashes involving animals;
- dust on the gravel roads within the municipality; and
- replacement of windshields.

Diana Posser advised that they would look into all these concerns and would be going out with the Director of Works and Protective Services to view the concerned areas.
