CALL TO ORDER

School District No. 60 Meeting

The Council meet with representatives from the School District No. 60 to discuss issues of joint concern. The following items were discussed:

- bringing broadband into the community and increase cell service between Hudson's Hope and Fort St. John;
- decreasing traffic speed in the school zone; the following ideas were brainstormed:
 - installing a flashing light;
 - borrowing the radar board from ICBC to remind drivers what the actual speed is that they are doing;
 - try to keep sidewalk snow free during the winter to decrease the number of children walking on the highway;
- different options for having the Northern Lights College use the school facilities for some of their courses;
- the different course options offered by the School District and their success stories;
- the future of schools and the space issues, possible solutions would be creating a middle school in Fort St. John and partnering with the community to find additional space; and
- whether full day kindergarten classes would have positive or negative affects and also the proposed pre-kindergarten option.
